

Creating a MP3 Voice Recording

- Download and install the Audio Record Wizard from <http://www.audioutilities.com/audio-mp3-recorder/audio-reocrd-wizard.htm> (trial version limited to 90 sec recording length)
- Plug in your microphone – traditional microphones (1/8" headphone jack) must be plugged into your sound card - usually this is the red jack on the back of your computer, next to where your speakers are connected
- **USB Microphone/Headsets only:** Plug the USB connector into any USB port, then go to the *Windows Control Panel* (**Start / Control Panel** or **Start / Settings / Control Panel**) and click on **Sounds and Audio Devices** or **Sounds and Multimedia**



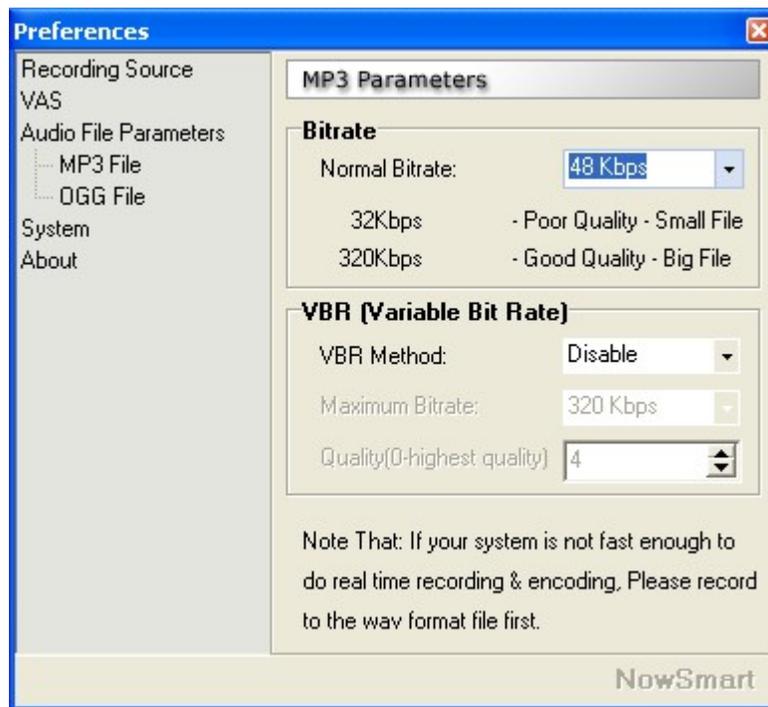
- Click on the **Audio** tab
- Change the default recording device to your USB microphone/headset and click **OK**
- Launch the **Audio Record Wizard** program



- Click on the **OPTIONS** button



- Change the *Recording Device* to **Microphone**
- Change the *Recording Quality* to 22050Hz, Mono
- Click on **MP3 File** under *Audio File Parameters*



- Change the *Bitrate* to **48 Kbps** and close the *Preferences* window



- Click on the **Record** button, give the new recording a file name and click **Save**
- Record your voice and click the **Stop** button when finished
